GOVERNOR’S EXECUTIVE ORDER N-25-20**
CORONAVIRUS COVID-19
AND SAN MATEO COUNTY HEALTH DIRECTIVE
FROM MARCH 14, 2020**

On March 17, 2020, the Governor of California issued Executive Order N-29-20 suspending certain provisions of the Ralph M. Brown Act in order to allow for local legislative bodies to conduct their meetings telephonically or by other electronic means. Pursuant to the current Shelter-In-Place Order issued by the San Mateo County Health Officer which became effective on March 17, 2020, and which was updated and extended on March 31, 2020; the statewide Shelter-In-Place Order issued by the Governor in Executive Order N-33-20 on March 19, 2020; and the CDC’s social distancing guidelines which discourage large public gatherings, the San Bruno City Council Chambers at the Senior Center is no longer open to the public for meetings of the City Council. Members of the public may view the meeting on a livestream at www.youtube.com/user/cityofsanbruno or on CityNet Services Channel 1. The recorded meeting will be also be made available for viewing on the City’s YouTube channel after the meeting has concluded.

If you would like to comment on any item on the agenda, please email us at councilsb@sanbruno.ca.gov and it will become part of the public record. Emailed comments should include the specific agenda item on which you are commenting or note that your comment concerns an item that is not listed on the agenda, or is a Consent Calendar item. The length of the emailed comment should be commensurate with the three minutes customarily allowed per speaker, which is approximately 300 words total. Staff will make every effort to read emails received by 5:00 p.m. the day of the meeting, but cannot guarantee emails received after that time will be read into the record during the meeting, although any emails received after this deadline will be kept with the agenda packet in the administrative file.
