- Requested data regarding police activity in underground crossings.

- Requested routine maintenance at the project site to avoid current issues at other undercrossing sites.
- Request for upgraded lighting and extra width added to undercrossing to make the site inviting for pedestrian use.

b. Adopt Resolution Authorizing the Placement of a Monument Plaque in remembrance of the 10 years that have passed since the 2010 PG&E Explosion and Fire and Appropriate Funds in an Amount Not to Exceed \$12,000 from the Park-in-Lieu Fund.
