- Sculpture Currently Located Within Footprint of New Recreation and Aquatic Center
- Current Recreation Center Scheduled for Demolition Early 2021

Location
- Factors in Selection of New Location
 - Visibility
 - Tranquility
 - Outside Dripline of Trees
 - Spaciousness
 - Outside Any Underground
