2019 Accomplishments

- ▶ Parking Restrictions
 - ▶ Recommended reducing red curb zone on Whitman Way between I-280 and Courtland Drive
 - ▶ Recommended establishment of a red curb bus zone on Elm Avenue for YouTube corporate shuttles
 - ▶ Reviewed proposal for a permit parking zone for employees of the Public Works Corporation Yard
 - ▶ Recommended passenger loading zone on San Mateo Avenue in front of La Petite Baleen Swim School



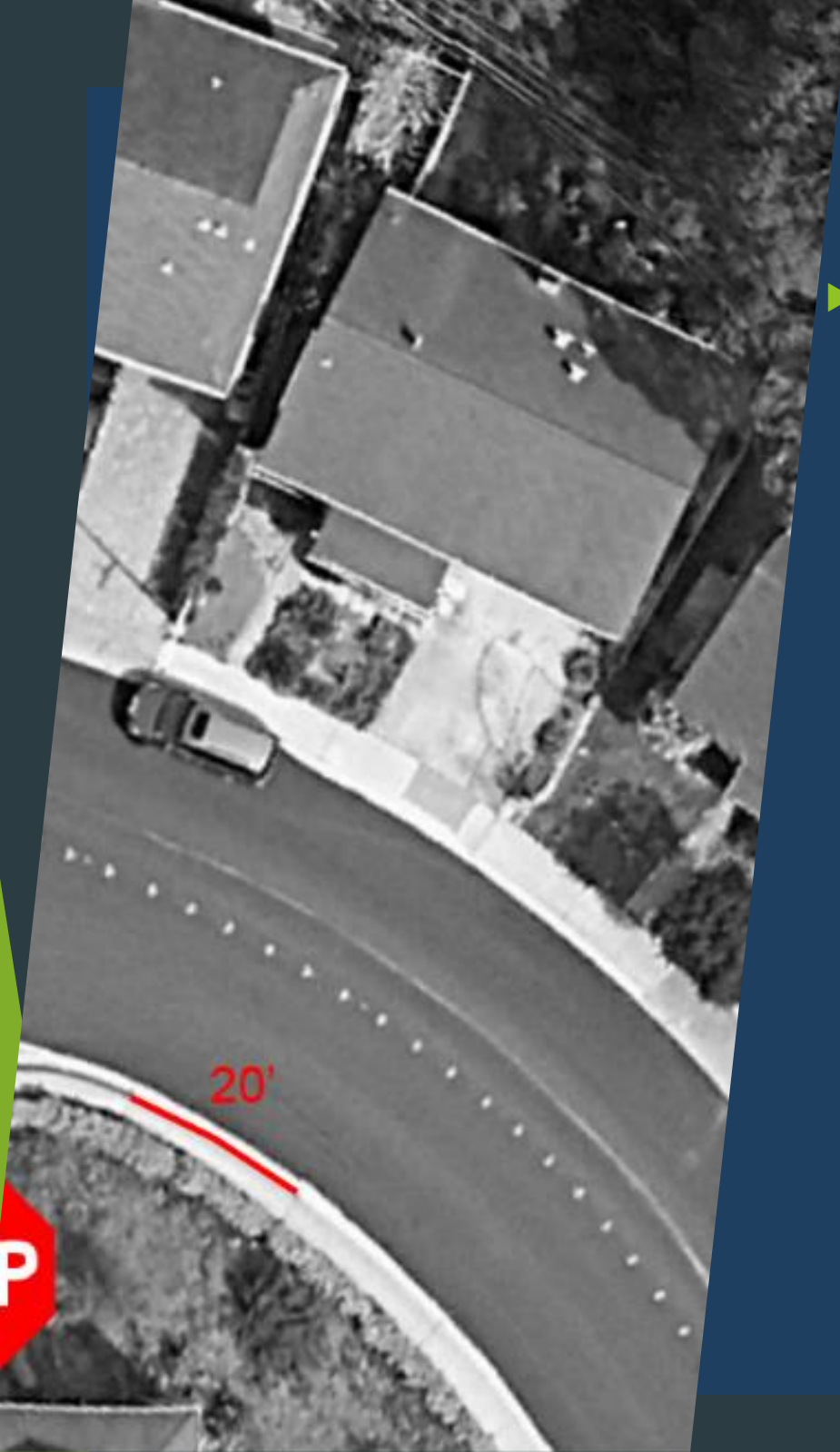
2019 Accomplishments

- ▶ Traffic Safety Evaluations
 - ▶ Recommended minor street stop controls at intersection of Santa Lucia Avenue and Parkview Drive
 - ▶ Reviewed proposal for minor street stop controls and warning signs at intersection of Willow Way and Valleywood Drive
 - ▶ Recommended minor street stop controls and other safety improvements at intersection of Amador Avenue and Del Norte Drive



2019 Accomplishments

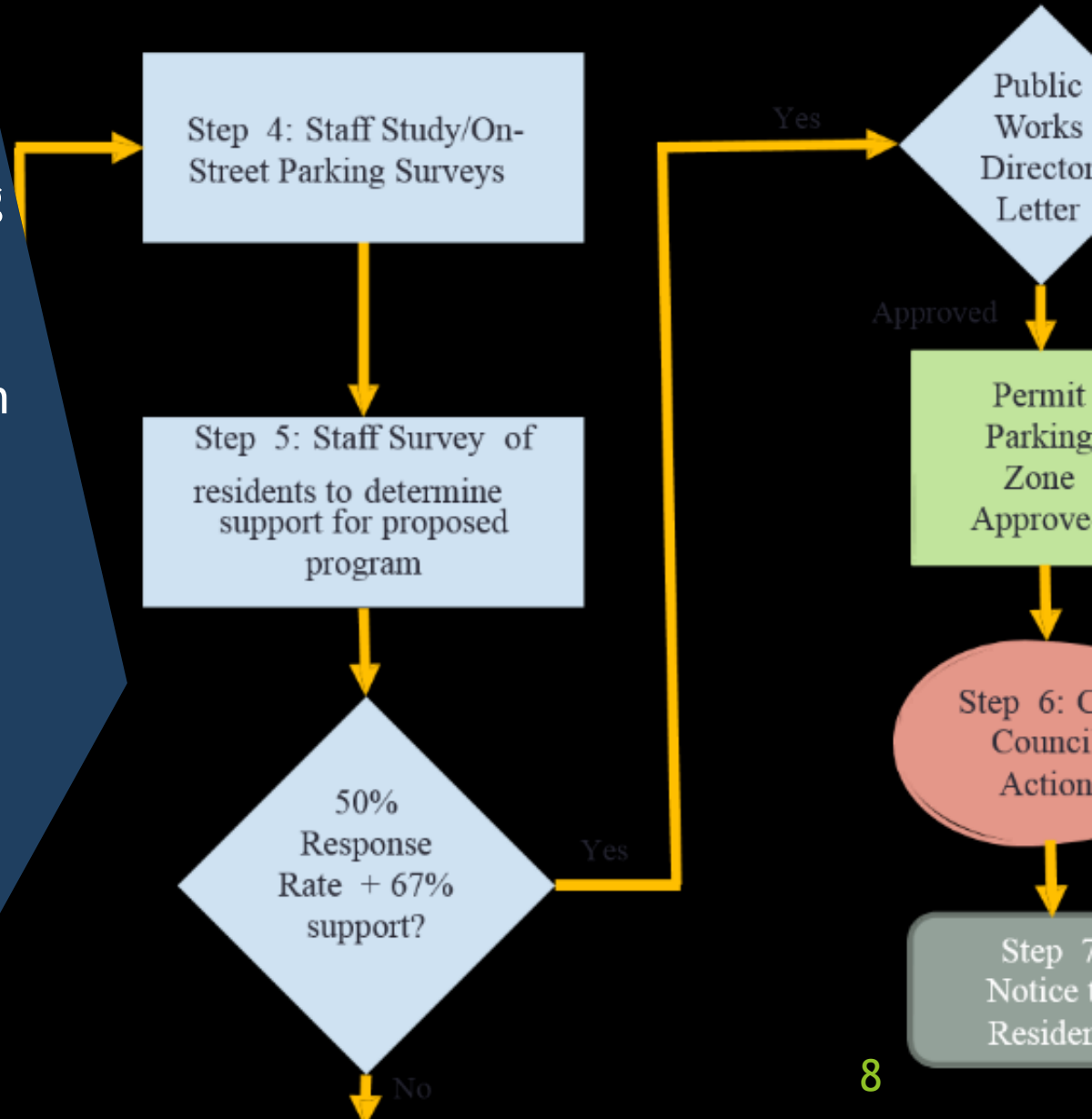
- ▶ Traffic Safety Evaluations (Continued)
 - ▶ Reviewed proposed striping modifications and parking restrictions at the intersections of Pine Avenue and 2nd Avenue, and Pine Avenue and 5th Avenue
 - ▶ Reviewed proposed traffic calming measures to be included in the Huntington Avenue and San Antonio Avenue Bicycle Corridor Project
