Vote on Behalf of the City

- On April 6, 2021, the City Council adopted a resolution submitting a Storm Drainage and Flood Protection Fee to the property owners of the City in a mail ballot election
- All property owners within the City will be assessed the proposed fee, including
 - Private parties
 - Public agencies
 - Non-profits
 - Religious institutions
- Consider authorizing the City Manager to vote on behalf of the City with respect to City parcels by the June 15 deadline



City Parcels

- 103 City-owned Parcels
 - ❖ Sample Facilities/Parcels
 - Civic Center
 - Corporation Yards
 - Recreation Facilities
 - Fire Stations
 - Parking Lots
 - Parks
 - Open Spaces, Footpaths
 - CityNet Operations
 - Utility Facilities
- Proposed Storm Drainage and Flood Protection Fee Rate: \$0.0498859 per sq. ft. of Impervious Area
- Estimated annual cost: up to \$134,000 (various funds)
