**3. PUBLIC COMMENTS FOR ITEMS NOT ON THE AGENDA**

**4. ANNOUNCEMENTS/PRESENTATIONS**

**a. Receive Update on COVID-19 Response Efforts.**

**Jennifer Dianos, Executive Assistant to the City Manager**, presented the update.

**b. Announce** a Spring Community Cleanup Event on Saturday May 1, 2021 at 8:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. The event location is 975 Sneath Lane and residents may drop off latex paint, bulky items, e-waste appliances and bags of garbage. Residents are prohibited from dropping off dirt, rocks or concrete. This event is open to San Bruno residents only and participants will be asked to show identification showing San Bruno residency. COVID-19 guidelines will be enforced, including the requirement of mask-wearing. This event is sponsored by Recology and the City of San Bruno.

**c. Announce** the possible nine-week closure of San Bruno BART Garage due to retrofitting and upgrades to the lighting system. The garage will be closed in stages, beginning with floors 3 – 5 on Monday April 26, 2021.

Medina to adopt a resolution, as amended supporting San Bruno businesses that qualified for the San Mateo County Strong Restaurant, Brewery, and Winery Relief Program, and authorizing the appropriation of up to \$290,000 from the Emergency Reserve Fund to provide individual business grants up to \$10,000. **Motion carried unanimously by roll call vote.**

The amendment to the resolution will state that the \$290,000 be funded using emergency reserve funds, but to immediately replenish the emergency reserve funds by using American Rescue Act funds.

- b. **Consider** Readopting Urgency Ordinance Establishing a Temporary Moratorium on Evictions for Non-Payment of Rent by Small Business Commercial Tenants Directly Affected by the COVID-19 Pandemic.

**Marc Zafferano, City Attorney**, presented the report.

M/S Hamilton/Mason to re-adopt an urgency ordinance establishing a temporary moratorium on evictions for non-payment of rent by small business commercial tenants directly affected by the COVID-19 pandemic. **Motion carried unanimously by roll call vote.**
