1. CALL TO ORDER

2. ROLL CALL/PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE – All Councilmembers were present.

Rico Medina, Mayor, introduced **Zidane Mili, San Bruno Resident**, who led the Pledge of Allegiance. Mayor Medina congratulated Zidane Mili for serving as a San Mateo County Explorer and for receiving the Explorer of the Month award for the month of February 2021.

b. Michael Salazar – Requested that staff explain the status of planting of a mature tree at Florida Park.


Linda Mason – Requested a study session regarding an update on Florida Park and other large current city projects.


8. **ADJOURNMENT** – The meeting adjourned at 9:50 p.m.
