BACKGROUND

- **October 9, 2018: City Council direction for comprehensive amendment of Municipal Code**
 - **Eleven Titles; Zoning Code (Title 12) being separately updated**
 - **Primary focus: update for internal consistency and with current law**
 - **Policy discussions for required revisions**
 - **Completed Titles 1-6 to date**

DETAILED REVIEW OF TITLE 7: PROPOSED SUBSTANTIVE AMENDMENTS TO SIX CHAPTERS

- **7.08: Traffic Safety and Parking Committee**
 - **Conform membership to current practices**
 - **Mitigate risk by defining duties more clearly**
- **7.12: City Traffic Engineer**
 - **Mitigate risk by clarifying duties**
- **7.16: Stopping, Standing, and Parking**
 - **Exempt curbing at rolled curbs**
 - **Omit blanket prohibition on “for sale” signs in vehicles**

DETAILED REVIEW OF TITLE 7: PROPOSED SUBSTANTIVE AMENDMENTS TO SIX CHAPTERS, (CONT.)

- **7.36: Abandoned or Inoperable Vehicles**
 - **Conformity with recently adopted amendments to Title 5 applicable to private property**
 - **Prohibits parking such vehicles unless fully enclosed and not visible**
 - **Clarify definition of inoperable vehicle**
 - **Prohibit storage of visible camper shells for more than 72 hours**

DETAILED REVIEW OF TITLE 7: PROPOSED SUBSTANTIVE AMENDMENTS TO SIX CHAPTERS, (CONT.)

- **Chapter 7.36: Abandoned or Inoperable Vehicles, cont.**
 - **Conformity with Title 5**
 - **Continue to allow parking one operable trailer, camper, boat, or RV where otherwise legally allowed**
 - **Applicability only to private property**
 - **Avoids risk and potential confusion with state statutes regulating parking on streets and highways**

DETAILED REVIEW OF TITLE 7: PROPOSED SUBSTANTIVE AMENDMENTS TO SIX CHAPTERS, (CONT.)

- **Chapter 7.40: Vehicles for Hire**
 - **Proposed for repeal as obsolete; City does not regulate taxicabs**
 - **Ride-sharing services are not taxicabs, and are separately regulated by CPUC**
 - **City can require drivers domiciled in City to obtain business license; propose amending Title 3**

DETAILED REVIEW OF TITLE 7: PROPOSED SUBSTANTIVE AMENDMENTS TO SIX CHAPTERS, (CONT.)

- **Chapter 7.40: Bicycles**
 - **Propose repealing permitting provisions as obsolete, except:**
 - **Retain definitions, which include motorized bicycles**
 - **Retain prohibition against riding on sidewalks**
 - **May regulate rental companies in the future**

NEXT STEPS

- Review proposed amendments
- Introduce ordinance
 - **Alternative: make substantive revisions and re-introduce at subsequent meeting**
- **Adoption scheduled for August 24, 2021**
 - Title 10 scheduled “out of order” for same meeting for introduction
 - **Primary amendment: County food packaging ordinance, plus only minor additional revisions**
 - **Three more Titles (8, 9, 11) after Title 10 is completed**
